Here are a few helpful tips to enhance your enjoyment.

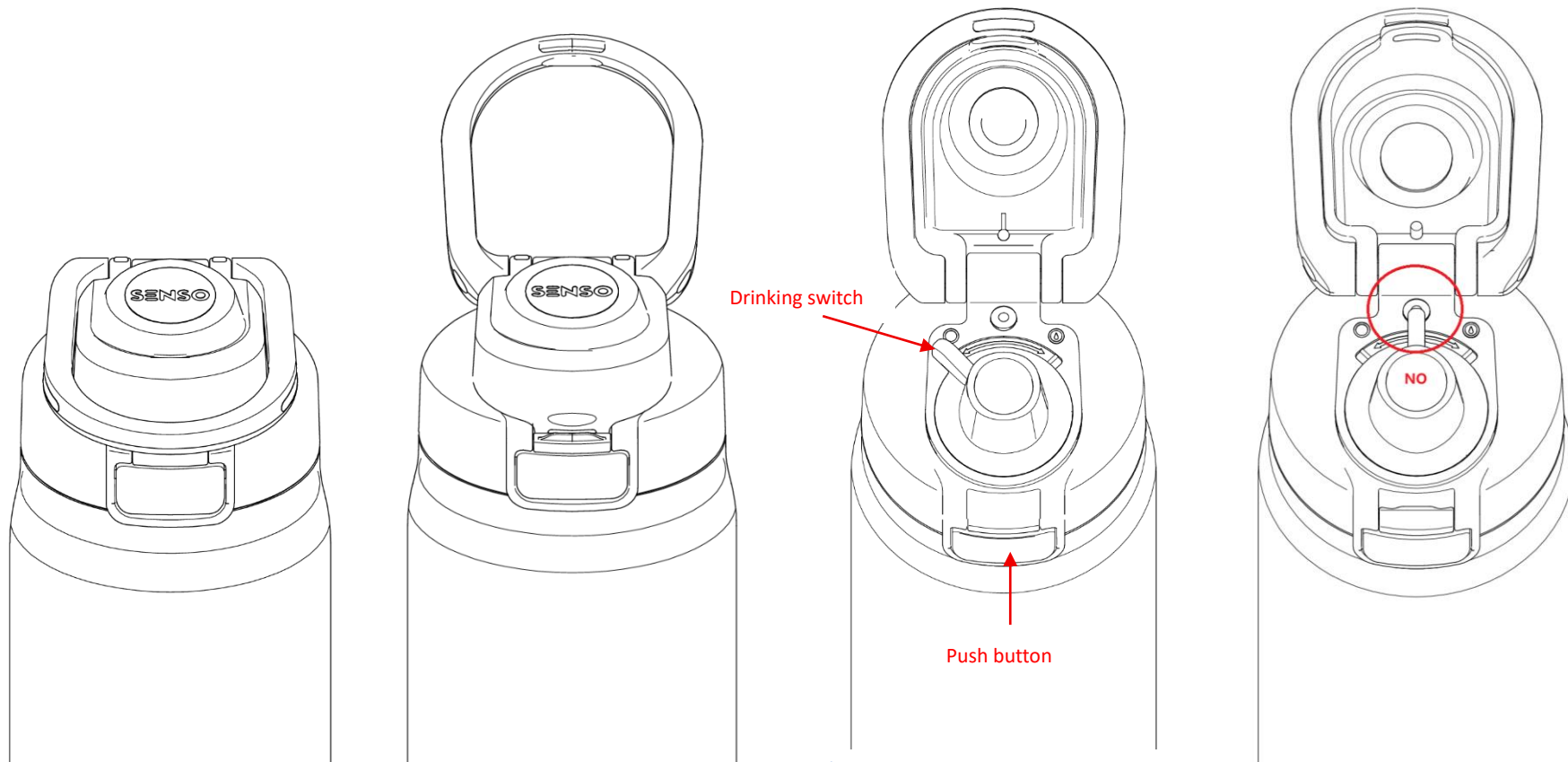
- Wash all parts in warm soapy water before using. Do not use cleansers with bleach or chlorine to clean this product.
- This product is able to keep liquids cold for a considerable period of time.
- Cold beverage only. Drinking hot beverages with the sipping function is not recommended.
- Do not over fill. Liquid may escape through the drinking hole when fastening the lid.
- Always ensure the lid is fastened securely before drinking.
- This product is not for use in a microwave oven and is not dishwasher safe. Recommended to hand wash only.
- Always point cap away from people and from yourself when opening.

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Following the instructions below for usage.

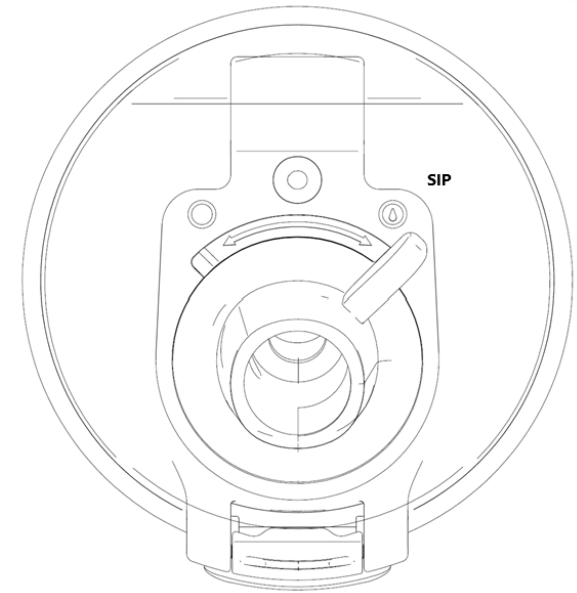
Open & Close

- When opening the lid, flip up the handle loop to unlock the push button on the main lid. Then push open the button on the front of the main lid. You can choose either sipping or chugging via the drinking switch.
- When closing the lid, flip back the top cap first to lock, then flip back the handle loop to secure the locking. Bottle is leak-proof.
- When closing the lid, NEVER leave the drinking switch in the center spot area as the sketch shows which may cause damage of the top cap.

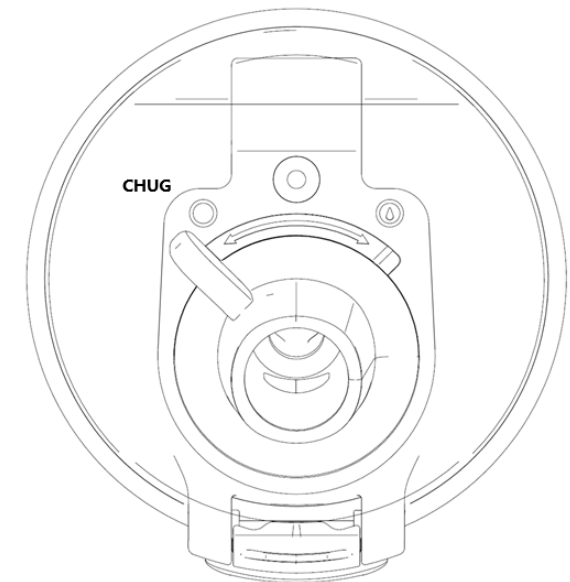


Sip or Chug

- i. Turn the switch to  for sipping.

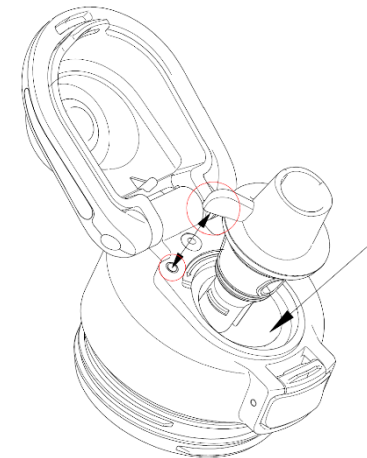
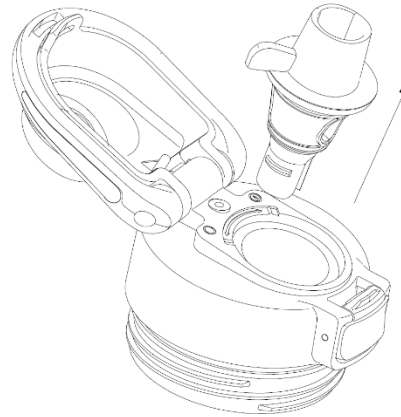
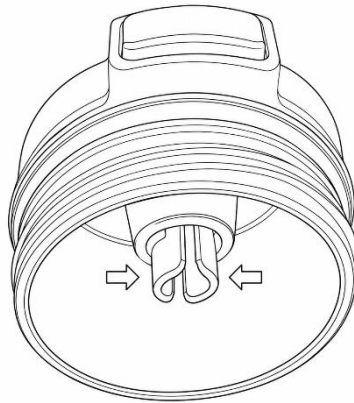
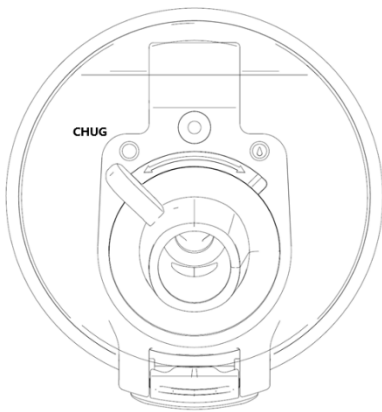


- ii. Turn the switch to  for chugging.



How to clean the drinking spout thoroughly?

- a) Turn the switch to  as the **Chug** status.
- b) Turn the lid upside down, pull off the inserted straw, clip the 2 parts of the straw holder.
- c) Turn the lid back, pull up the drinking spout to disassemble it from the main lid. Ready for spout cleaning.
- d) Align the switch on the drinking spout with the  **Chug** spot, push the drinking spout down to assemble it to the main lid securely.
