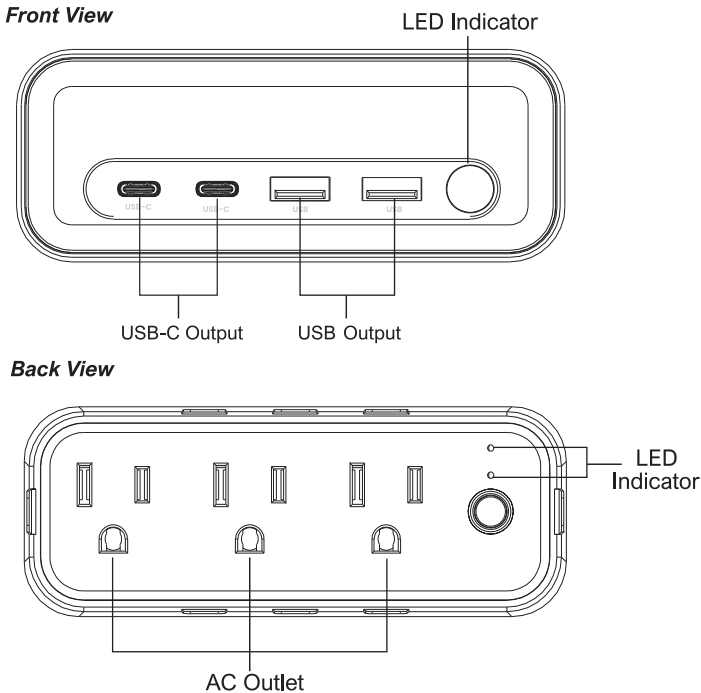

TECH SPECIFICATIONS

- Input: 125V~60Hz 15A, 1875W
- USB-A Output: DC 5V/3A, 9V/2A, 12V/1.5A (18W Max.)
- USB-C Output: DC 5V/3A, 9V/2.22A, 12V/1.67A (20W Max.)
- Combined Output: DC 5V/3A (15W Max.)
- Working Temperature: 32°F ~ 122°F (0°C ~ 50°C)

INSTRUCTIONS

- Plug the AC wall plugs on the charging station into a wall outlet. The LED indicator will **glow BLUE** to indicate the charging station is ready to use. The charging station can turn one wall outlet into 3 AC sockets.
- Using the cable of the device you wish to charge, connect the charging cable to your device with the appropriate connector.
- Connect the other end of the cable to the USB-C port or USB-A port of the charging station.
- The charging station will begin to charge automatically.

- When both USB-C ports and USB-A ports are in use, a total 5V/3A of output power will be divided between the ports. The charging station will automatically detect each device and provide the optimal charging power.
- **Note:** *Surge protection safety will shut down the charging station if it detects the output power exceeds 20W. You will need to unplug at least one device when the surge protection is activated.*

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- This product is NOT a toy, keep away from children and pets.
- Only use the product according to the instructions in this manual. Never use the adapter for anything other than its intended purpose.
- Do not open this product or attempt to repair the unit yourself if it is not working properly. Doing so risks fire, shock or injury.
- When not in use, the product should be stored in a dry, cool location, away from sources of water or heat.
- Do not expose the product to extreme temperatures (heat or cold), open flames, humid or wet conditions.
- Do not submerge in water. Do not use in a location where the product could fall into liquid.
- Do not use if the product is damaged. If the product is damaged, it MUST be serviced or replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent before using again.
- Unplug the product from wall socket when it is not in use.
