

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- This is a non-medical product suitable for relieving muscle strain after exercising.
- · Please use it according to your own needs and under the guidance of your doctor.
- This device is NOT a toy, keep away from children and pets.
- Only use the device according to the instructions in this manual. Never use the device for anything other than its intended nursose.
- Do not open this device or attempt to repair the unit yourself if it is not working properly. Doing so risks fire, shock or injury.
- When not in use, the device should be stored in a dry, cool location, away from sources of water or heat.
- Do not expose device or charging cable to extreme temperatures (heat or cold), open flames, humid or wet conditions
- Do not submerge in water. Do not use in a location where the device or charging cable could fall into liquid.
- Unplug the charging cable when not in use. Do not pull the charging cable to disconnect or use the cable as a handle.
- Do not use if device or charging cable is damaged. If device or charging cable is damaged, it MUST be serviced or replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent before using again.

INSTRUCTIONS

Be sure to fully charge the speaker before using for the first time.

CHARGE THE MASSAGE GUN

- Plug the small connector of the included charging cable into the USB-C charging port on top of the massage gun.
- Plug the large connector into a USB power source, such as the USB port on a computer or into a compatible 5V USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall socket
- The LED indicator will illuminate RED when charging and turn OFF when fully charged.
- The massage gun CAN NOT be used during charging. It will power off automatically when being charged.

USING THE MASSAGE GUN

- Press and hold the [Power] button for 3 seconds to power on. The LED indicator will glow BLUE when massage qun is powered on.
- Press the [Power] button to change the toggle speed level between low, medium and high.
- · Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds again to power off.
- . The LED indicator will flash BLUE to warn of a low power of battery.

• The massage gun will power off automatically after 30 minutes on the same speed

NOTE:

- DO NOT use the massage gun directly on soft skin surface to avoid damage to your skin. Wear dry and soft clothing or place a dry towel on muscle area to be massaged
- . The massage time for the same area should not exceed 60 seconds.
- Press gently into the muscle. If not feeling pain or discomfort, you can apply a higher speed and add more pressure on the soft tissue parts of the body. DO NOT do this on the head or any bone parts of the body.
- Frequent high-speed and high-pressure massage on the same part will cause abrasions. Stop using it if you feel pain or discomfort.
