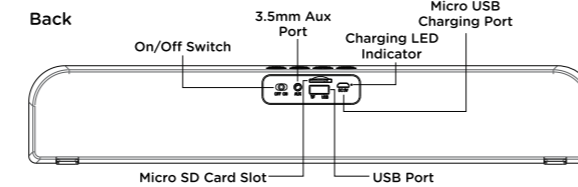
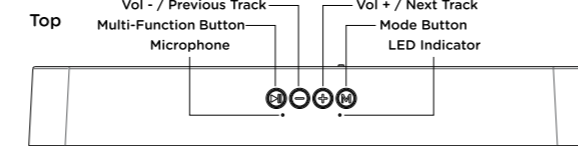

**Safety Precautions**

- This product is NOT a toy, keep away from children and pets.
- Only use the device according to the instructions in this manual.
- Never use the device for anything other than its intended purpose.
- ONLY use the supplied power cable.
- Do not open this product or attempt to repair the unit yourself if it is not working properly. Doing so risks fire, shock or injury.
- When not in use, the device should be stored in a dry, cool location, away from sources of water or heat.
- Do not expose device or power cable to extreme temperatures (heat or cold), open flames, humid or wet conditions.
- Do not submerge in water. Do not use in a location where the device or power cable could fall into liquid.
- Unplug the charging cable when not in use. Do not pull the charging cable to disconnect, or use the cable as a handle.
- Do not use if device or power cable is damaged. If device or power cable is damaged, it MUST be serviced or replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent before using again.

**Instructions**

Be sure to fully charge the speaker before using for the first time.

**Charge the Speaker**

- Plug the small connector of the included charging cable into the micro USB charging port on the back of the speaker.
- Plug the large connector into a USB power source, such as the USB port on a computer or into a compatible 5V USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall socket.
- The charging LED indicator on the back will glow **RED** when charging and turn off when fully charged.
- It takes approximate 3 hours to fully charge the speaker.

**Pair & Connect with a New Device**

- Switch the On/Off Switch to “ON” to turn on the speaker. The LED indicator on top will flash **BLUE** indicating the speaker is in pairing mode.
- Open the Bluetooth menu on your smart devices and search for new devices.
- When you see “Rhyme Light Up Speaker” listed, tap it to connect. The LED indicator on top will stop flashing when paired successfully.
- Previously paired speaker will pair automatically.
- The speaker will automatically shut off after 5 minutes when it is disconnected.
- Switch the On/Off Switch to “OFF” to turn off the speaker.

**Play & Calling**

- Press the Multi-Function button to play/pause your audio.
- Press and hold the Vol+/Next Track button to skip to next track; Press the Vol+/Next Track button to increase volume.
- Press and hold the Vol-/Previous Track button to skip to previous track; Press the Vol-/Previous Track button to decrease volume.
- When there is an incoming call, press the Multi-Function button once to answer an incoming call, and again to end the call.
- Press and hold the Multi-Function button to reject an incoming call.

**Mode Switch**

The speaker will enter wireless mode when power on. It will enter USB mode or micro SD mode automatically when plugged in USB flash drive (not included) or micro card (not included). Press the Mode Button to switch mode.
