

Using the Writing Tablet

- Detach the stylus from the side, and write or draw on the LCD
- (For best writing experience, please only use the included stylus with this writing tablet.)
- Switch the erase lock to ON or OFF to enable or disable the erase function.

• When the function is enabled, press the erase button on the front to erase entire screen.

- Insert stylus through stand and hanging hole to use as a stand.
- Use the magnet on the back to magnetically attach to fridge or any other flat steel surface.
- Hang tablet by using the stand and hanging hole directly, or inserting a string through the hole and securing.

Changing the Battery

- The writing tablet is powered by 1 x CR2016 button cell battery (included).
- Use a screwdriver to unscrew the battery compartment on the back and slide the battery compartment cover to the left to open.
- After the battery is replaced, put the battery compartment cover back in place and screw until secured.

Safety & Care

- Gently wipe the LCD screen with a soft cloth to clean.
- Do not press stylus too hard against the LCD screen.
- Do not use sharp objects on the screen.
