

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- This device is NOT a toy, keep away from children and pets.
- Only use the device according to the instructions in this manual. Never use the device for anything other than its intended purpose.
- Do not open this device or attempt to repair the unit yourself if it is not working properly. Doing so risks fire, shock or injury.
- When not in use, the device should be stored in a dry, cool location, away from sources of water or heat.
- Do not expose device or charging cable to extreme temperatures (heat or cold), open flames, humid or wet conditions.
- Do not submerge in water. Do not use in a location where the device or charging cable could fall into liquid.
- Unplug the charging cable when not in use. Do not pull the charging cable to disconnect, or use the cable as a handle.
- Do not use if device or charging cable is damaged. If device or charging cable is damaged, it MUST be serviced or replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent before using again.

INSTRUCTIONS

The humidifier should always be placed on a firm and flat surface when using.

HOW TO INSTALL

- Pull the top humidifier unit upward firmly to open the water tank.
- Place the retaining spring into the positioning slot at the bottom of the tank, then insert the cotton wick.
- Fill the tank with clean tap water to about 75% of its capacity.
- Place the top humidifier unit back onto the tank. When closing, ensure
 that one end of the cotton wick aligns with the positioning slot at the
 bottom of the tank, and the other end aligns with the hole at the bottom
 of the humidifier unit.
- Make sure the humidifier unit and the water tank are properly aligned and fully secured.

HOW TO USE

- Place the humidifier on a firm, flat and stable surface.
- Plug the small connector of the included charging cable into the USB-C charging port on the humidifier.
- Plug the other end of the cable into a USB power source, such as the USB port on a computer or into a certified USB adapter (not included), and plug into a wall socket.
- The LED light will **flash and turn off** indicating the humidifier is in standby mode.
- Press the [Power] button to turn ON the humidifier. The humidifier will enter continuous spray mode.
- Press the [Power] button again to switch to intermittent spray mode.
- · Press the [Power] button again to turn OFF the humidifier.
- Press and hold the [Power] button to turn on the LED light on the top of humidifier.
- Press and hold the [Power] button to switch lighting mode between cycling, fade and white.
- Press and hold the [Power] button again to turn off the LED light.
- The humidifier will automatically shut off after 3.5 hours of use to prevent the tank from running dry.

NOTE

- Please make sure the cotton wick in the humidifier is completely soaked for a few minutes before using the misting function.
- It's recommended to use clean tap water for the humidifier only.
- **DO NOT** add essential oils to the humidifier. Doing so may clog the cotton wick and cause the unit to malfunction.
- It's recommended to wash the water tank once a week.
- It's recommended to replace the filter cotton swab every 3-4 weeks.
