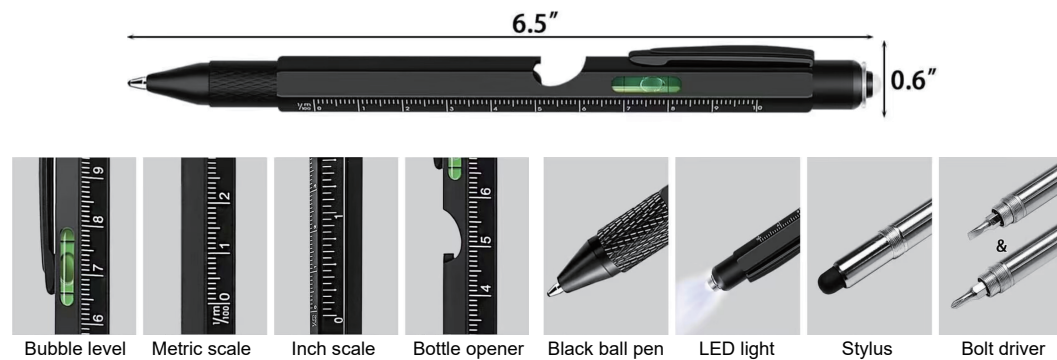

#### Q&A

##### How to use the LED light?

Before using the led light, please remove the yellow insulating sheet under the lamp head.

##### How to use a screwdriver?

1. Hold the pen barrel and twist out the pen tip in clockwise, then you can take out a small tool pen.

**NOTE: The first step is to rotate out, not pull out.**

2. Rotate the cap of small tool pen, then you can use the screwdriver.

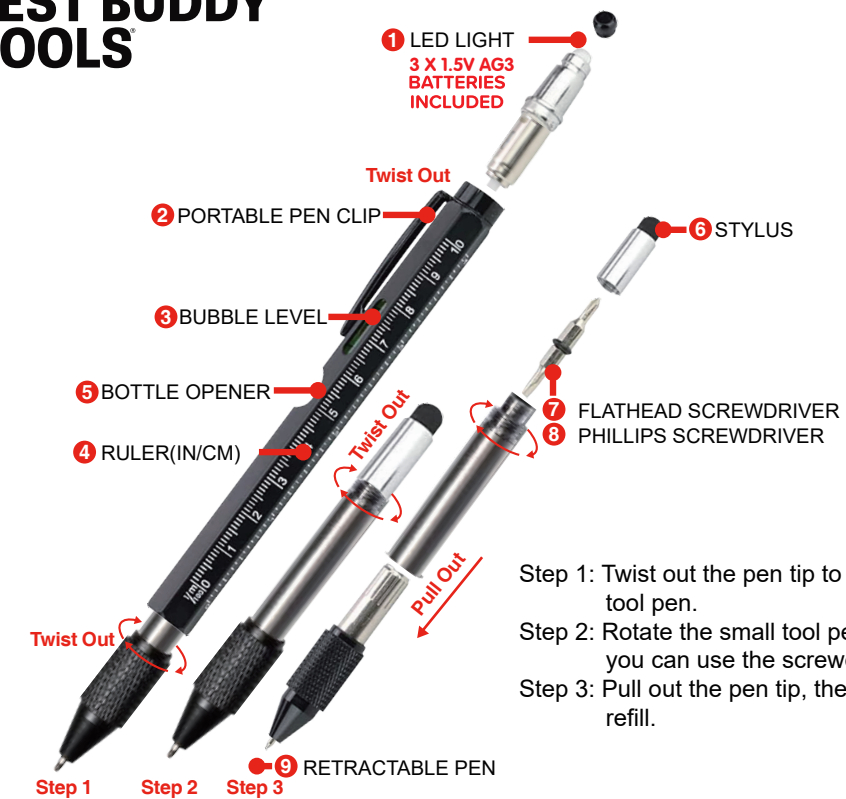
##### How to replace the battery?

1. Batteries: 3x1.5V AG3 button cells (included)
2. Unscrew the pen cap and take out the LED light set.
3. Unlock the battery case and take out the inner battery holder.
4. Replace the new batteries.(3xAG3 button cells)

##### How to replace the ink refill?

1. Hold the pen barrel and twist out the pen tip to get the small tool pen.
2. Put out the pen tip, the pen refill is in it.
3. Unscrew the pen refill to take it out.
4. Replace with the new one and screw in to lock.

Step 3: Pull out the pen tip, then replace the refill.

## ⚠ WARNING

- f) Ensure the batteries are installed correctly according to polarity (+ and -).
- g) Do not mix old and new batteries, different brands or types of batteries, such as alkaline, carbon-zinc, or rechargeable batteries.
- h) Remove and immediately recycle or dispose of batteries from equipment not used for an extended period of time according to local regulations.
- i) Always completely secure the battery compartment. If the battery compartment does not close securely, stop using the product, remove the batteries, and keep them away from children.
